## 2013 Australasian Parliamentary Educators' Conference Evaluation Report

### Summary

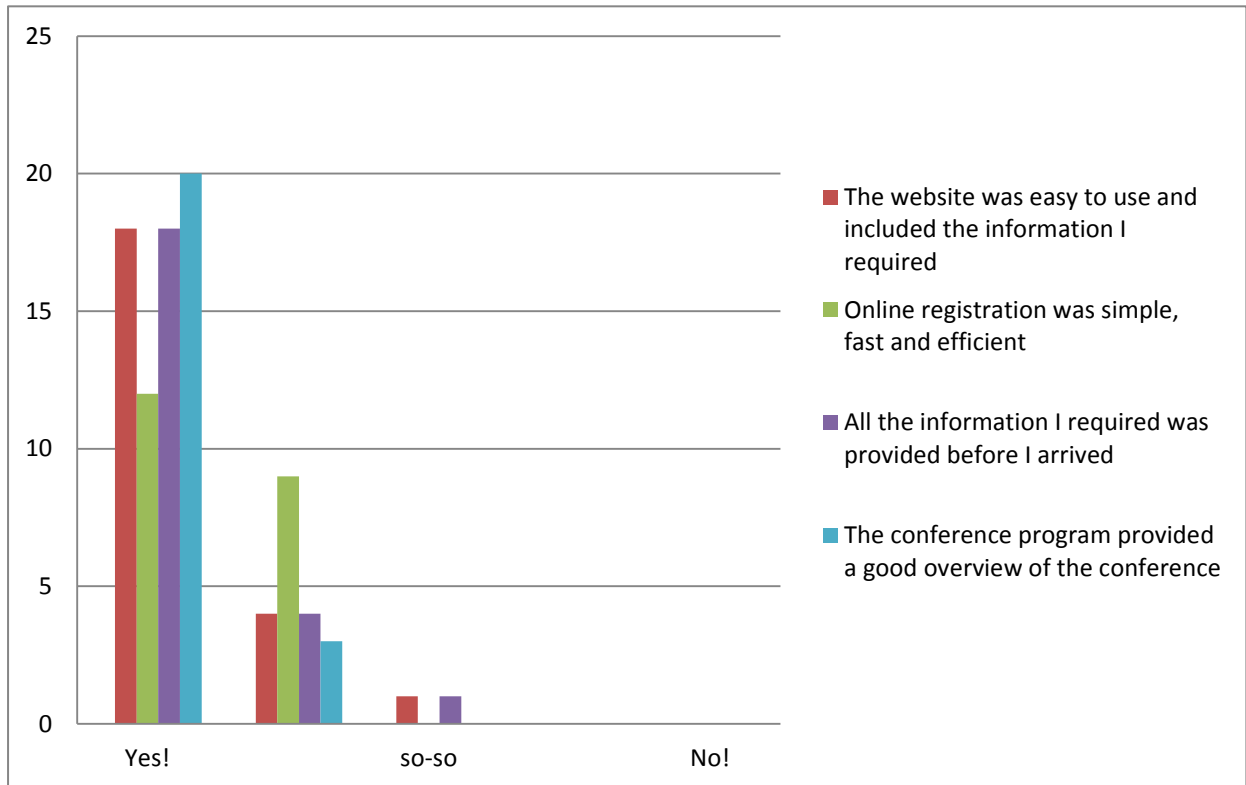

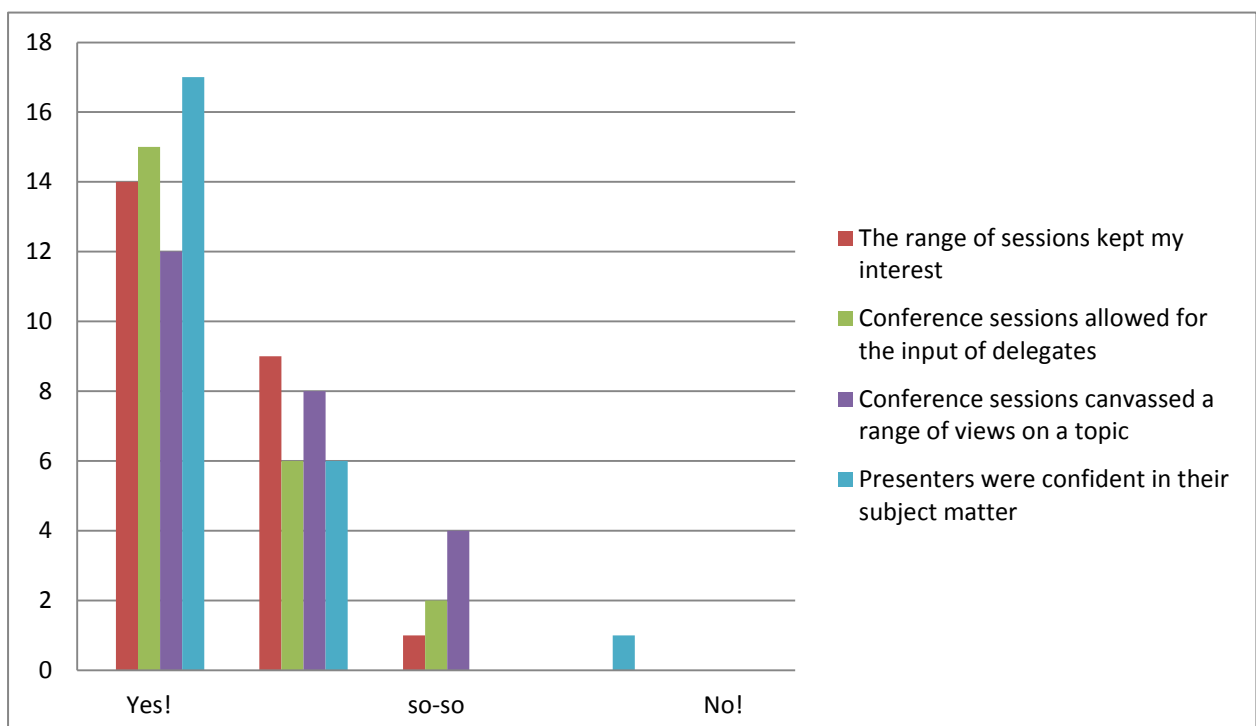
Valuable suggestions were received as to how to build on the strengths of the 2013 conference.

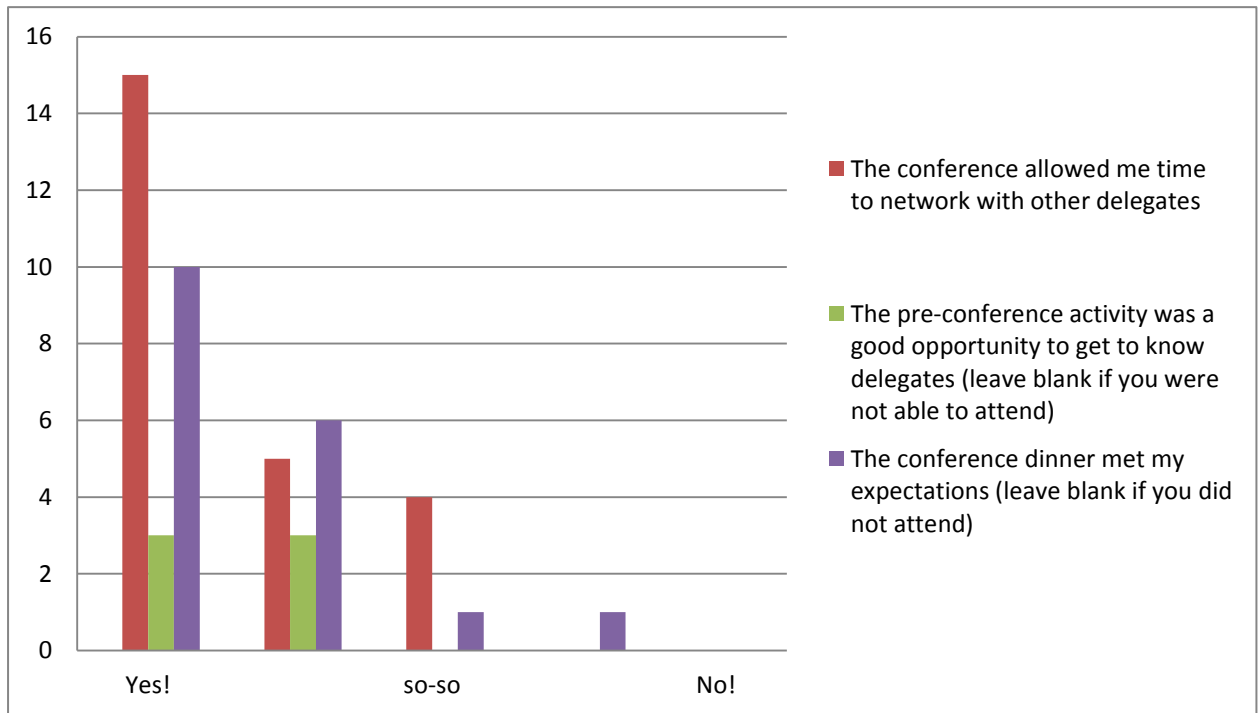
