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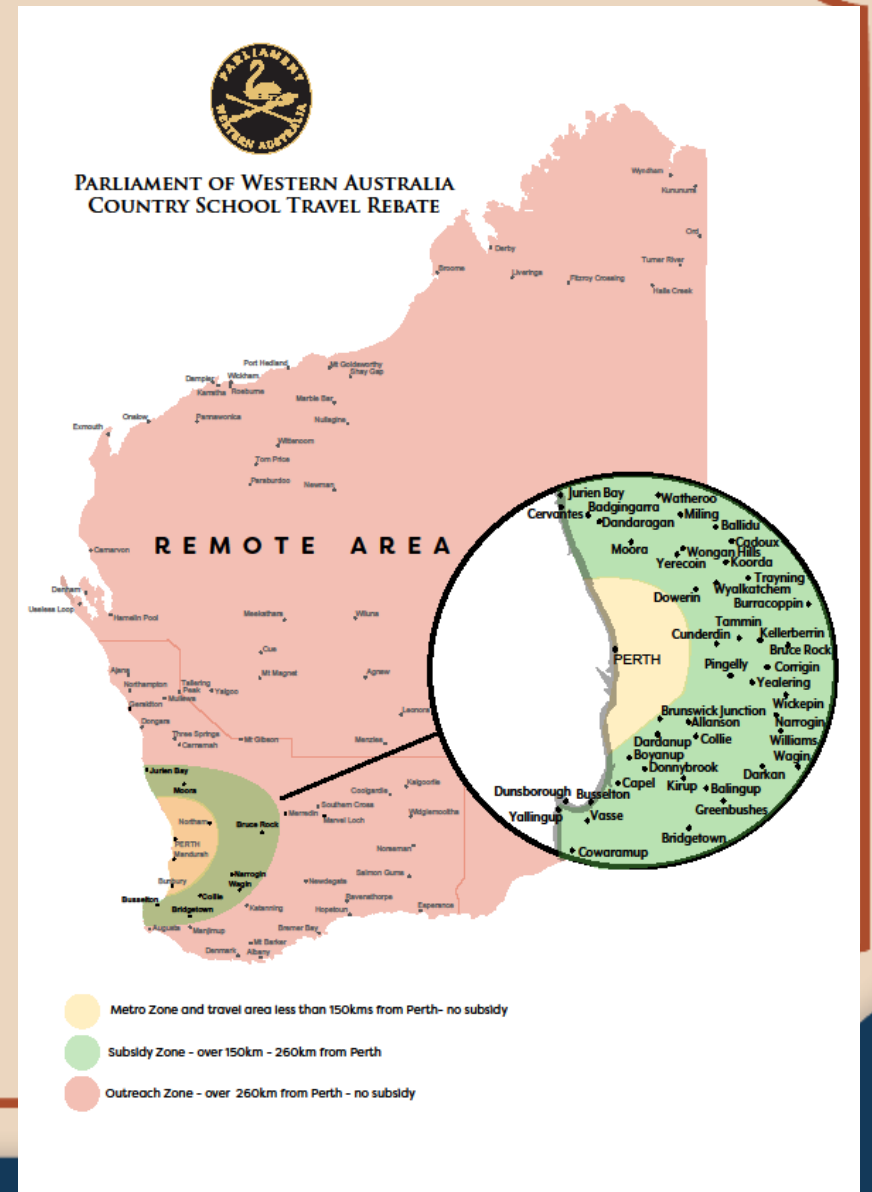
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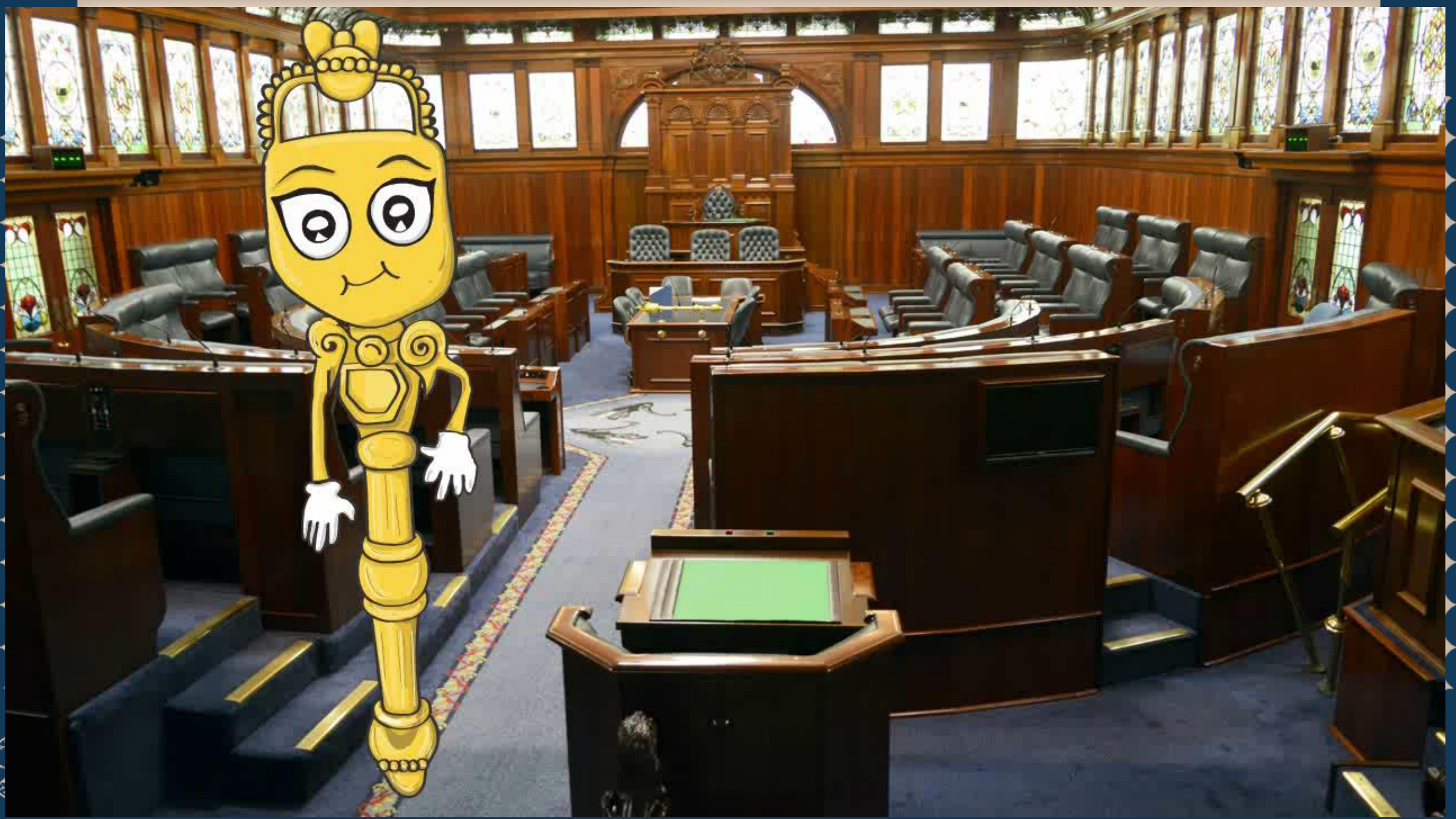


Country School Travel Rebate

Tackling the tyranny of distance

The Parliamentary Education Office provides a rebate of \$200 per school / per year to travel to Parliament House to participate in the Parliamentary Civics and Citizenship tour program. Eligibility is for schools located a minimum of 150 kilometres from Perth.
