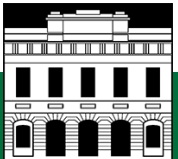

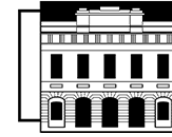
# Flyers

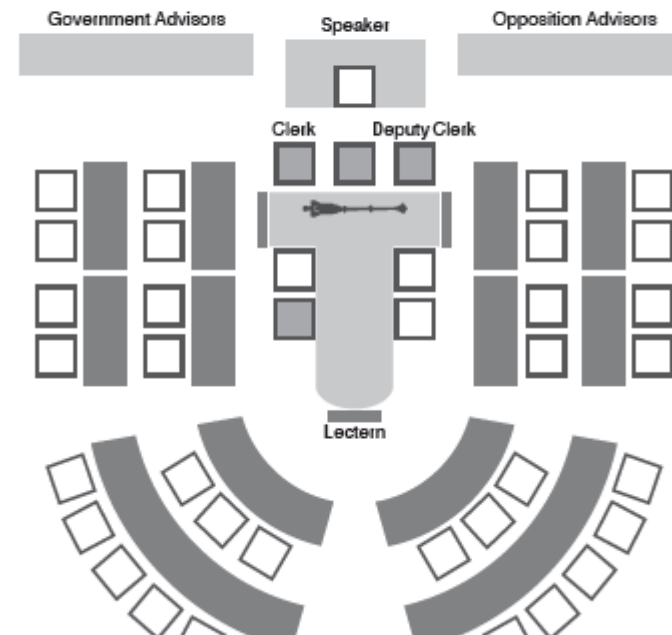
# Question Time

- ✓ Differentiated

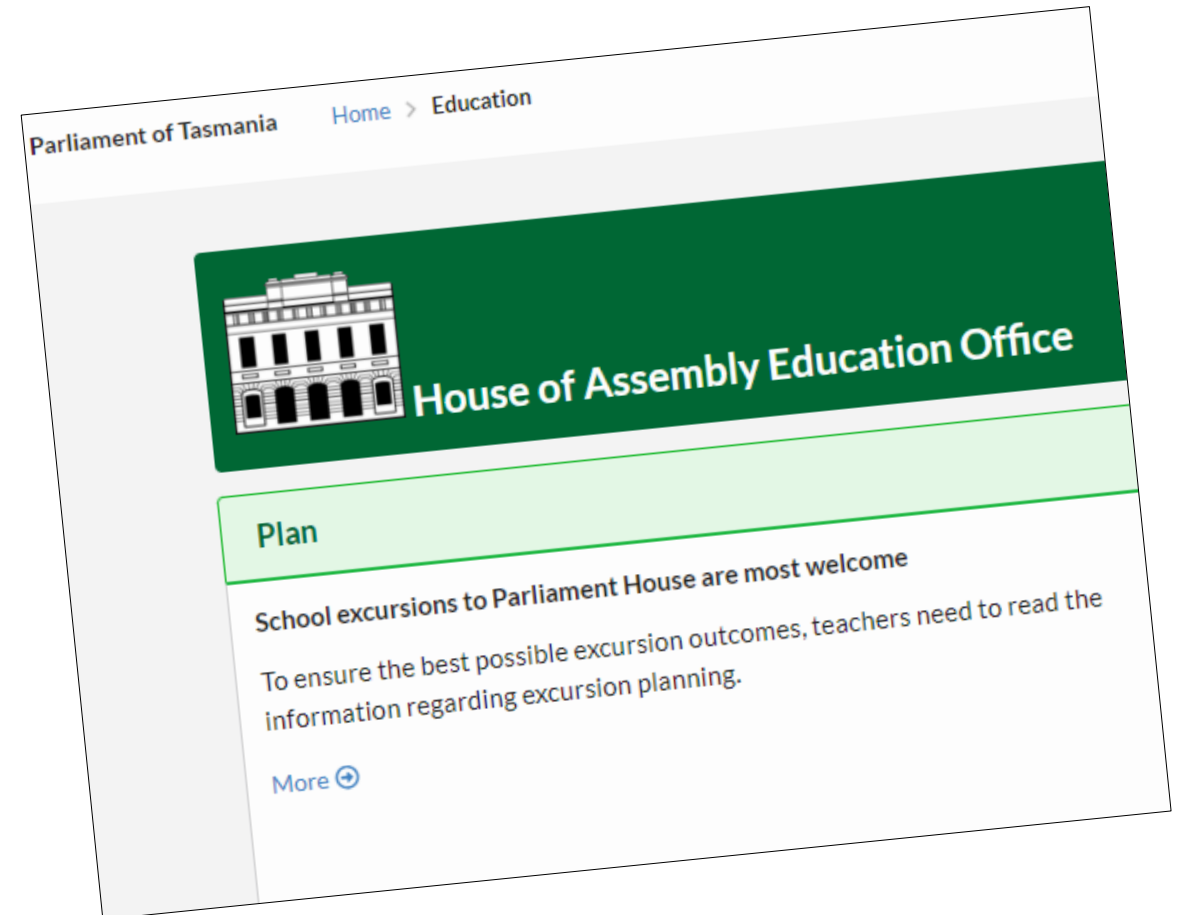


# Website

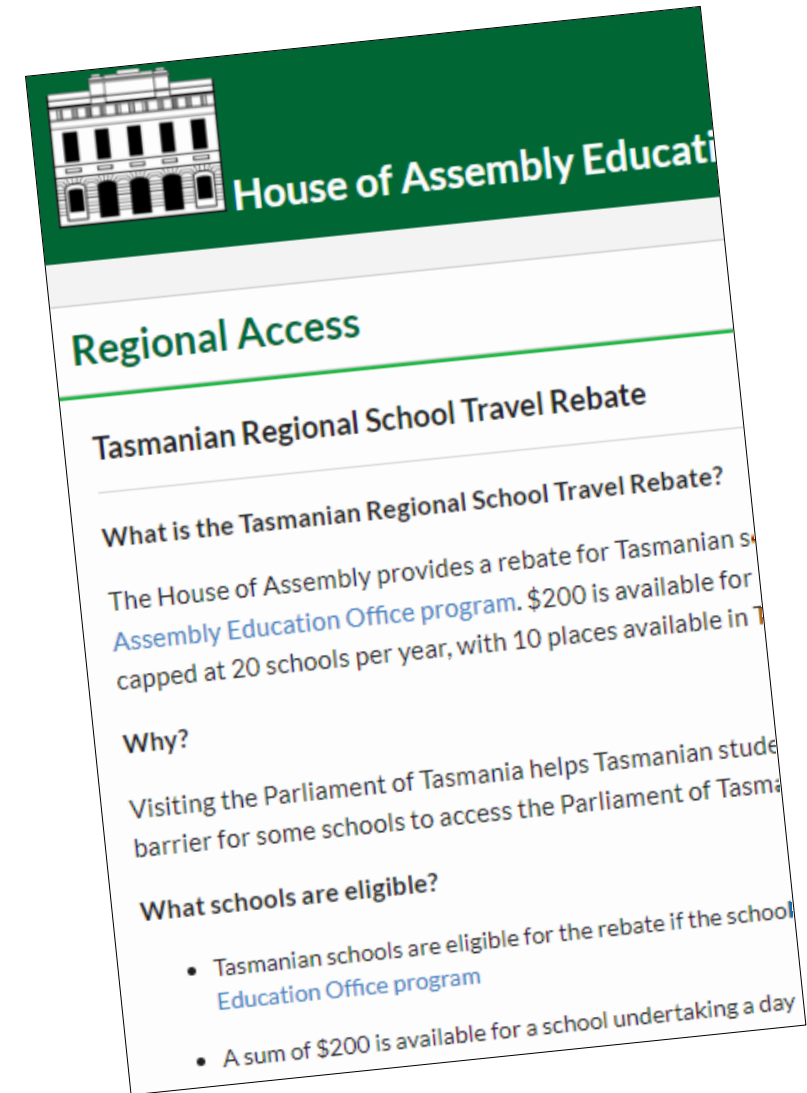


# Travel Rebate
